OVERVIEW

This program is for Perio Residents and Periodontists preparing to take the Oral Exam (Part II) for certification by the American Board of Periodontology; practicing periodontists looking for a comprehensive review and an update in periodontics; and general dentists and dental specialists who are interested in periodontics. Two options for this program are offered, one option (#01-22-2.5-Video) is for a 2½-day comprehensive review and update. The second option (#01-22-Video) also includes 1½-days of mock oral board exams after the conclusion of the 2½-day comprehensive review and update.
